Step 1: Open your picture in the photo editor and tap on the Text icon.



Step 2: Type your text and tap on the check mark to confirm.



Step 3: Tap on the arrow icon in the bottom left corner to open the fonts menu.



Step 4: Select the font package you'd like to use. We chose the <u>Ultra Fonts pack</u>.



Step 5: Select your font. Drag the arrow icon to adjust the size of your text and drag the edge of the text to adjust the dimensions. Drag the text to place it on your image.
